Practical Nursing Diploma Program

Thank you for your interest in Nunez Community College Practical Nursing Technical Diploma Program. The Practical Nursing (PN) Program at Nunez Community College is a 16-month (4 semester) program. Upon successful completion, graduates are eligible to apply for licensure through the Louisiana State Board of Practical Nurse Examiners (LSBPNE).

The Nunez Community College PN program is a limited, competitive admission program. The number of qualified applicants may exceed the number of positions in a class. Individuals who are not selected into the class for which they apply will be given the opportunity to be considered for the next scheduled class by written request only.

Applicants to the PN Program must be registered students at Nunez Community College and meet <u>all</u> admission requirements of the College *before* applying to the PN program. To register with the College, please contact the Admissions Office at (504) 278-6467 for further information or visit www.nunez.edu/admissions.

- Applications for the Spring (January) PN entry will be accepted August 1st through October 31st. Priority consideration will be given to those who apply by September 1st.
- Applications for the Fall (August) PN entry will be accepted from March 1st through May 31st. Priority consideration will be given to those who apply by April 1st. If closing date falls on a weekend or holiday, applications will be accepted the following business day.

In order to apply, you must meet the following:

- U.S. citizen or permanent resident of the U.S. (Copy of permanent resident card will be required.)
- **High school diploma or GED** (High School seniors may apply in the Spring of their senior year for the Fall PN program entry.)
- Registered student at Nunez Community College
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 for all previous college work attempted
- Take a placement exam and have acceptable placement exam scores from one of the listed placement exams:

¹Completion of Math 1300/1299 (College Algebra) or Math 1200/1199 (Survey of Mathematical Concepts) or a higher level of math with a grade of "C" or better may substitute for low Math Placement Scores.*

²Completion of English 1010/1009 (English Composition I) or a higher level of English with a grade of "C" or better may substitute for low Reading/Language Placement Scores.*

*<u>ALL</u> potential nursing students <u>must</u> take the ACCUPLACER Next-Gen or ACT entrance exam to apply to the nursing program, even if student is substituting college courses for low scores. No exceptions. Scores must be within three (3) years of application to the nursing program.

Students may retake the ACCUPLACER- Next Gen. with a minimum 1 week waiting period between each retest. The student can retest two times only (total of 3 attempts to meet scores). After 3rd attempt, the student must enroll in preparation courses as applicable. After passing the preparation course, you will have a maximum of 1 attempt to reach the minimum score for the admission requirements. Only Mary Fernandez, Dean of Nursing and Allied Health, can approve additional testing beyond the maximum of 4 attempts for entry purposes.  Completed BIOL 1010- Introduction to Anatomy and Physiology (A&P) and BIOL 1500- Nutrition and Diet Therapy** with a grade of "B" or better within 3 years of applying to Practical Nursing program

**Completion of <u>both</u> BIOL 2300 (A&P I) and BIOL 2400 (A&P II) may be substituted for BIOL 1010. Both classes must have a grade of "B" or better within 3 years of applying to the Practical Nursing program.

<u>All documents must be submitted in person to the Nursing Department, emailed to nursing@nunez.edu, or be received by mail to the Nursing Department by application deadline.</u>

Application Process

- 1. Complete a Practical Nursing Program Application (this is a separate application from the College), which may be found on the Nunez webpage under the Practical Nursing Program.
- 2. Pay application fee of \$20.00 to the Bursar's office in the Administration building on campus.
- 3. Submit completed application along with all required documents listed above:

All components for application must be submitted by application deadline to be considered. Incomplete applications will not be considered for class selection. All applications are subject to review by the Admissions Committee.
